(PLANTS START TALKING AND SINGING)

Sun comes out and it does shine Green plants photosynthesize Animals eat the grass and leaves Sun gives us our energy

BILLY

Where's MOM and DAD? I want to go rafting NOW.

(He takes the oar and messes with it, and the raft starts floating down the river).

ASHLEY

Billy! Look what you did!

BILLY

Whoops. Now what?

ASHLEY

Now we put on our life-jackets!

(They put on their life-jackets, we see the raft go floating down the river. Billy takes a bottle of water, drinks it and throws it in the river).

ASHLEY

What are you doing? You can't just throw that out!

BILLY

Why not?

MAGPIE

SQUAK!! Because only Dodos do that! And they're extinct. You're polluting! Some of us birds make our homes along this Colorado River, and we don't like people messing up our nests! SQUAWK! Give a hoot don't pollute.

ASHLEY

Who are you? I thought it was an owl who says that.

MAGGIE

I'm Maggie the Magpie. I'm a magical bird. I say whatever I want!

BILLY

You do magic tricks?

MAGGIE

I do tricks like PICK UP TRASH THAT PEOPLE THROW INTO THE RIVER! Squawk!

(MAGGIE tries to get the plastic bottle but can't catch it. She flaps and flaps, getting mad).

Well, now you made me mad as a magpie who's all wet. Follow that bottle. Row row row your boat! Quickly! Let's go!

BILLY

This is fun! I feel like a pirate!

MAGGIE

FUN? Our future's at stake! All feathers on deck. Ahoy mateys. Give a hoot don't pollute!

BILLY

Can fish feel happy?

FISH

Scientists have discovered that fish have feelings!

ASHLEY

There's the bottle!

FISH

Get it out of my river.

SCIENTIST

(He is doing research along the river, hiking, with lots of

measuring things).

Ladies and Gentlemen! I'm your friendly research scientist. Did you know that water comes in 3 states? Liquid. Gas. And Solid!

(The band makes the water sounds after every word. With ice, the

scientist is holding a cup of ice, which the bear comes to get).

POLAR BEAR

Got ice? I need it? This global warming is changing my habitat.

SCIENTIST

Yeah, but the ice will melt before you get home with it!

POLAR BEAR

(Polar bear shrugs and disappears).

SCIENTIST

(Jumps into the boat).

Mind if I ride along?

ASHLEY

Where are you going?

SCIENTIST

Downstream! Isn't that where everything goes? Downstream? Water's grand!

MAGGIE

Grand! Look! We're going into the Grand Canyon! White water, white water! Hold onto your feathers!

(The raft goes through white water and the music revs up).

ASHLEY

Hold onto your hat!

FISH

I only have scales!

MAGGIE

Ahh!!!!

SCIENTIST

Did you know that the Colorado River carved the Grand Canyon over millions of years!

ASHLEY

I don't care right now! I don't want to get smashed to smithereens!

FISH

Sardines! Did you say sardines? I had a cousin who married a sardine.

BILLY

This rocks!

ASHLEY

ROCKS! Rocks!

MAGGIE

Squawk!!!!!

ASHLEY

Whew, we made it! And there's the plastic bottle!

SCIENTIST

I see!

MAGGIE

The Sea! I smell salt!

SCIENTIST

Did you know that the average amount of salt in the sea is 3.5%?

FISH

I can't live in salt water! I'm a fresh water fish.

SCIENTIST

Of all the water on Earth, only around 2.75% of it is fresh drinking water.

FISH

See you later alligator!

MAGGIE

This is the Pacific Ocean, no alligators here.

SCIENTIST

It's the **largest** in the world, covering 69,375,000 square miles, or 35% of the earth!

BILLY

What is that? Garbage!

SCIENTIST

Were' in the Pacific Plastic Patch! Twice the size of Texas! Miles and miles of floating plastic pieces of garbage everywhere!

ASHLEY

Plastic bottles! Millions of them!

BILLY

I didn't throw all those in the water!

ASHLEY

But you threw one in! Look! Plastic toothbrushes! Plastic hangers, plastic shoes, plastic toys, and plastic bags--

MAGGIE

--that birds think are food. They eat 'em, get sick, and die!

DOLPHIN

And dolphins!

SEA TURTLE

And sea turtles!
